

Phonak Roger Phone USB headset conversion kit



USB Headset Conversion Pack for Phonak Roger is available to enable you to use a headset where the only option you have is plugging in a USB wired headset, usually with some kind of PC telephony system, for example Skype, Linx or similar.

We supply a replacement headset setup that does not interfere with your hearing aids and unlike using a traditional headset in the normal way does not cause discomfort for hearing aid wearers.

This pack has been tested with PC based laptops running Windows XP, Vista, 7 and 8, and Mac OSX. This solution is specifically for replacing USB wired headsets only where no other alternative is available, and where you still need to be able to use a Phonak Roger system in conjunction with a headset to converse via PC based telephony.

The audio from calls will divert through your Phonak Roger system and directly into your ears resulting in crystal clear phone conversations. The use of this equipment in the right way will be far more comfortable than wearing a traditional headset, absolutely fine for hearing aid wearers. Straightforward set up instructions are included with the pack.
